## THREE EDUCATIONAL POLICIES

- Acquire the ability to plan/propose and communication skills that can be applied to global practices.


## 2, CURRICULUM POLICIES (CURRICULUM TO ACHIEVE ACADEMIC/EDUCATIONAL TARGET) THE CURRICULUM OF PROGRAM PROVIDES;

- Provide a group of area studies courses to understand regional diversity, and a group of global studies courses to understand relationship between nations/nation and society/nation and non-state entity from a universal perspective.
- Collaborate 2 groups of courses organically in order to deal with various problems occur in diverse global space, such as social development and international political/economical phenomena.
- Provide courses for on-site studies to engage with field research in order to cultivate practical ability for investigation and resolution of various global problems.
